Treasurer Report:

AYSO Region 741 Checking account totals as of September 30, 2006: \$47,585.33

Old Business:

Newsletter Volunteer – Tina Viramontes is now in charge of producing the Newsletter.

New Business:

A. City Fees Proposal – Jeff Paul reported that the City Council had proposed a use fee of \$2.00/hr./field for the 06' season with a 25 cent/hr increase each year through 2009. There are approximately 1200 AYSO players currently registered, with an average of 1100 hours of field use per season, totaling \$2.00 per player for field use this season. However, expected enrollment increases coupled with yearly fee increases would eventually cause the dollar per player amount to grow beyond \$2.00 per player. PRYSC will counter with a proposal of a fixed \$3.50 /player fee for a period of five years, to be renegotiated at the end of the five year term. Richard motions to support the PRYSC proposal, Nancy seconds, and the motion passes.

B. Steve reports that a separate U5 program is not mandatory, but in order to meet the 07' Guidelines for U6 (3 v 3) and U8 (5 v 5) Region 741 will need to purchase more goals and corner flags. The Fields Budget will be used for these purchases.

C. Syl has requested increased education and enforcement of the “No Slaughter Rule”. Richard S. has agreed to email coaches regarding this matter. He will also inform them that any coach who does not honor the rule jeopardizes their opportunity to coach All Stars, Tournaments, and the next regular season.

Jeff Paul needs detailed facts of this rule abuse in writing. Please email him reports of any occurrences, at which point he will address coaches individually. Jeff will inform Division Coordinators of the necessity to check final scores on each game card.

D. The “Paso Cup”, formerly EOY, will be held 11/18 & 11/19/2006. Scoring will be calculated the same way as Area and Section.

Don reminds Coordinators that they are needed as field monitors during this tournament.

Grape Crush is scheduled for 1/21 and 1/22/07 as an AYSO only tournament. G.C. meetings begin in November.

All Board members are required to participate in either the Paso Cup or the Grape Crush in addition to registration duties.

E. Donnie would like a zero tolerance rule enacted for coaches who are arguing with and mistreating referees.

A Board/Discipline committee has been proposed for enforcement purposes.

Jeff needs documentation of negative coach behaviors in writing.

Referees will be asked to note these incidences on the back of game cards as documentation.
