Treasurer Report: Dave McCue reported \$63,426.43 in the account. Dave reported that the deposit had been made on the soccer balls. Uniforms were about \$22,000. There were 8-NSF checks, 5-players are on the payment plan. Registration fees were low this year.

New Business: A. Jeff P. reported that July 26th is the day to assemble the Coaches Binders at his house at 6:30pm. Jeff also talked about the coaches training, and cautioned about other clinics not following AYSO guidelines. AYSO also follows age specific training.

B. Richard S. asked that the PR Soccer Club account be renamed. We also have 4 bank accounts. The account has \$9,500 and a CD account has \$ 1,500 combined roughly \$11,000 and put it in a CD at the current rate and with a yearly renewal. The Grape Crush account is at Heritage Oaks Bank and that has roughly \$10-11,000 in it. The amount is kept in there as a cushion. Dave McCue 1st and Sergio 2nd the motion passed.

C. Sergio V. talked about the All-Star Review process. Thanks to Iris and Ted E. on what a great job they did. The committee Chris, Dave, Steve M. Sergio, Keith, Julie, Richard C., Breta Y, Syl. The season is self supported. Players and parents help cover costs. The all-star has a separate bank account. Need to update sponsorship forms. Divisional coordinators are a critical link to success. The committee meets w/coaches that want to be all-star coaches. This is for U-10 and up. Players are nominated. Teams need Referees for tournament play. Refs also need intermediate training, Possible charge for referees not on a team and the cost of traveling. Mandatory meetings for ratings and coaches applications. December 15th is the deadline for applications. Teams would consist of U-14 15 players, U-12 14 players and U-10 9-10 players. Sergio has a full report for any additional questions.

D. Sponsorship forms need to be updated. \$75.00 donation will not be receiving a plaque. \$300 and up will. The plaques reduce the money donated to AYSO. IRS forms for donors was discussed.
